Observing Yom Ha'atsma'ut

Israel has officially designated 5 Iyyar as Independence Day. When that date falls on Friday, as it does this year, Yom Ha'atsma'ut is advanced to 4 Iyyar so that celebrations do not conflict with Shabbat.

In addition to the ritual observances, the following are customary:

- Eating a festive meal that includes foods from Israel
- Singing songs related to Israel

Also, all mourning practices associated with the Omer period are suspended.

For example:

- Weddings and other communal celebrations are permitted.
- Haircuts are permitted.

In Bemidbar 9:6–14 we learn that people who were unable to partake of the Pesah offering because of a particular ritual impurity or because of distant travel were obligated to perform a “make-up” Pesah offering a month later. Pesah Sheni is, therefore, a somewhat festive occasion.

As a reminder of the Pesah offering, some eat מצצה *matsah* on this day.

- Weddings and other communal celebrations are permitted.
- Haircuts are permitted. (In a year when Lag Ba'omer falls on Sunday, a haircut is permitted on Friday prior to Shabbat.)

- ☞ ⁵26:10–46 This aliyah contains the section of rebuke and warning called the תוכחה tokheḥah. Read this section in a somewhat subdued voice to symbolically minimize the trepidation that the congregation experiences upon hearing the message of these verses. However, for the verses voicing promise of God's protection and reward (10–13, 42, and 45) and for the concluding summary verse (46), use a normal Torah reading voice. When reading in a subdued voice, be sure that all words and *te'amim* (tropes, cantillations) are still clearly audible to the congregation.

- ☞ ⁸27:34 When the Torah reader concludes a book of the Torah:
 1. Roll Torah scroll closed.
 2. Congregation chants חזק ונתחזק ḥazak ḥazak venithazzek (oleh remains silent).
 3. Torah reader chants חזק ונתחזק (oleh remains silent; if Torah reader is the oleh, omit this chanting).
 4. Open the Torah scroll.
 5. The oleh kisses the Torah, closes it, and continues with the usual concluding berakhah.

- ☞ ⁸26:46 Some congregations following the triennial schedule do not recite חזק ונתחזק until the 3rd year of the cycle. Others recite it every year, following the above procedure.
