Shabbat Hahodesh is the last of four special Shabbatot before Pesah. It falls on the Shabbat before Nisan begins, unless Nisan begins on Shabbat. In that case, Shabbat Hahodesh coincides with Rosh Hodesh.

The special *maftir* reading from the second Torah scroll describes the night of the first Pesah, including eating the Pesah lamb sacrifice together with unleavened bread and bitter herbs, and painting the blood of the sacrificed lamb on the doorposts of Israelite houses. The passage, containing both the story and various laws of Pesah, connects us to our ancient past and prods us to accelerate our preparations for Pesah, which is only a few weeks away.

Fast of the Firstborn (private daytime fast)

Fast of the Firstborn and Siyyum

A firstborn male of a mother or a father observes this daytime fast on the eve of Pesah, recognizing that in Egypt the firstborn of Israel were saved, while the firstborn Egyptians died in the tenth plague.

If the firstborn male is a minor, the father fasts in his place. However, if the father is also a firstborn, the mother fasts in the child's place.

It is encouraged that a **סייום siyyum** (completion of study of a tractate of rabbinic literature) be held to remove the obligation to fast from those attending.

1. Conduct the **סיים** after Shaḥarit.
2. Conclude the **סיים** with the prayers and the expanded *kaddish derabbanan* that is special for this occasion. Texts can be found at the end of a tractate in many editions of the Talmud and in the *Moreh Derekh* rabbi's manual.
3. Hold a **מצווה סעודת מצווה se'udat mitsvah** (festive meal celebrating the performance of a mitzvah, in this case, the **סיים**).

As participants in the **סיים**, all firstborns present are permitted to eat at the festive meal and during the rest of the day as well.

Preparation of a Flame for Yom Tov

On Yom Tov, kindling a *new* fire is not permitted; however, the use of an *existing* fire for cooking or other purposes is permitted. On Shabbat, neither kindling a new fire nor transferring an existing fire is permitted.

To allow you to light candles for the second day of Yom Tov (Saturday night), ensure you have a fire burning before the *beginning* of Shabbat that will continue to burn at least until after dark when Shabbat ends. For example:

- A burning candle that lasts for more than 25 hours
- A pilot light on a gas range (*not* a gas range with an electronic starter)

Observing Pesah at Home

Candle Lighting for Shabbat and Yom Tov

1. Before candle lighting time, prepare a flame that will burn at least 25 hours (see p. 92). For example, light a long-burning candle near the Shabbat and Yom Tov candles so that it is readily accessible for lighting candles the next night.
2. Light the candles at least 18 minutes before sunset.
3. Recite 2 ברכות *berakhot*: S303 F718

Candle Lighting for Yom Tov after Shabbat

1. Do not light the candles until after dark, when Shabbat ends. Some wait until three stars appear, or at least 25 minutes after sunset, which is at least 43 minutes after the time set for lighting candles yesterday, before Shabbat. Others wait longer; consult your rabbi for the proper waiting time in your community.
2. Do not *strike* a match. Instead, transfer fire to the candles from an *existing* flame (p. 92) by inserting a match or other stick into the flame.
3. Do not *extinguish* the match or stick. Instead, deposit it on a non-flammable tray or dish, and let it self-extinguish. Alternately, a wood *safety* match held vertically (flame up) usually self-extinguishes quickly.
4. Recite 2 ברכות *berakhot* (for full text, see p. 3): S303 F718

Wearing Tefillin on Hol Hamo'ed

Whether or not to wear תפלין *tefillin* during Hol Hamo'ed is a long-standing controversy. Ashkenazic Jews tend to wear תפלין; Sephardic and Hasidic Jews tend not to wear תפלין. The predominant practice in Israel is not to wear them. Some who wear תפלין do not recite the ברכות *berakhot*.

Determine your individual practice according to these instructions:

- If there is an established custom in your family, follow it.
- If there is no established custom in your family, consult your rabbi.

If you wear תפלין, remove them just before the beginning of Hallel.

On Yom Tov cooking is permitted, but only to prepare food for that particular day. On Shabbat it is forbidden to cook at all. Therefore, preparing food for a Shabbat that follows a Yom Tov presents a difficulty. To allow cooking for Shabbat without violating the laws of Yom Tov, Jewish law sanctions a method of *combining* (עֵרוּב) the cooking for Yom Tov and Shabbat. This procedure allows for cooking for Shabbat on a Friday Yom Tov by beginning the cooking *before* the beginning of Yom Tov and in anticipation of Shabbat. (The בְּרַכָּה *berakhah* and accompanying declaration are found below and in the *haggadah* and most siddurim.)

1. Before Yom Tov begins, take two prepared foods, customarily a baked food (e.g., מצה *matsah*) and a cooked food (e.g., a hard-cooked egg or a piece of cooked chicken or fish).
2. Recite the בְּרַכָּה *berakhah*: S306 F716

Preparation of a Flame for Yom Tov

Kindling a *new* fire is not permitted on Yom Tov; however, the use of an *existing* fire for cooking or other purposes is permitted.

To allow you to light candles for Shabbat and the second day of Yom Tov, ensure you have a fire burning before the *beginning* of Yom Tov (Thursday before sunset) that will continue to burn at least until candle lighting time on Friday. For example:

- A burning candle that lasts for more than 25 hours
- A pilot light on a gas range (*not* a gas range with an electronic starter)

Observing Yom Hasho'ah

This day was set by the Knesset in Israel to commemorate the Holocaust and to honor the heroes of the resistance movements during the period of the Holocaust. Although no fixed liturgy for the occasion has emerged yet, many congregations mark the occasion with changes in the liturgy. The following are customs practiced and resources used in various congregations:

- Congregations read all of (or selections from) *Megillat Hashoah: The Shoah Scroll* (published by The Rabbinical Assembly). This work, comprising six chapters in memory of the six million, is available from the USCJ Book Service.
- Many congregations read additional texts appropriate to the Holocaust and the heroic efforts of resistance fighters. Modern siddurim offer a selection of such readings. 5387 W198 F828
- In some congregations, a single candle is lit; in others, participants light six *yortsayt* candles.
- *אל קלא רחמים El ma-le rahamim* is recited. 5196 W198 F522
- Many congregations recite a communal **יתום קדיש** Mourner's Kaddish.
