**Shiv'ah Asar Betammuz and the Three Weeks**

On this date in 70 C.E., the Roman army broke through the walls of Jerusalem.

Three weeks later, on the ninth of Av, the Second Temple was destroyed.

Shiv'ah Asar Betammuz inaugurates a three-week mourning period. Public celebrations such as weddings and concerts are avoided. Some refrain from haircuts.

Because the 17th of Tammuz falls on Shabbat, the fast is delayed until the 18th of Tammuz.

- This is a minor fast day, so called because the fast does not begin until dawn.
- The fast (from both eating and drinking) lasts until dark.
- The *sheliach tsibbur*, the Torah reader, and those called for *aliyot* should be fasting.
- The preferred fast-day procedures apply when at least six of those who are counted for a minyan are fasting.
- If it is ascertained (without causing embarrassment) that fewer than six are fasting, follow the procedures printed in gray and marked with ♠.
